SENATE COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Student Government Association (SGA) Senators for the Abraham S. Fischler School of Education (FSE) are elected by the FSE-SGA executive board. Powers of the Senate Committee involve serving as a liaison between students and FSE-SGA executive board.
