**Autism Grades K-12  
Nevada Endorsement  
Entrance Requirements**

- 1) Complete the admission application packet and submit a \$50.00 non-refundable fee (U.S. dollars) made payable to Nova Southeastern University (NSU).
- 2) Official transcripts from all previously attended academic institutions. An official transcript indicating conferral of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution is required.
- 3) A minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average (CGPA) is required for all students. Applicants who do not meet the 2.5 CGPA requirement must submit Graduate Record Exam (GRE) scores (a combined score of 1000 for the verbal and quantitative scales only).

If the applicant does not meet the minimum 2.5 GPA or GRE score requirement, the applicant may enroll in a maximum of six (6) credit hours and must earn a grade of B or better in each course during the first term of enrollment for conditional admission. Students who do not earn a grade of B or better in each course will be subject to dismissal from the program.

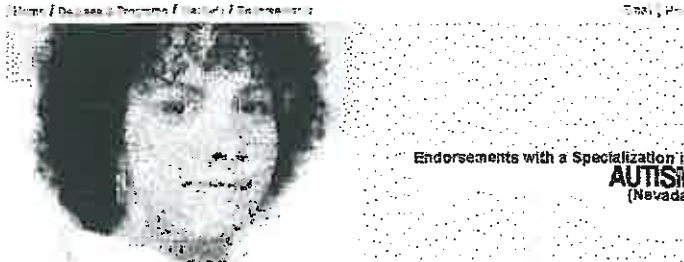

About the Specialization

The Autism Endorsement Program at the Nova Southeastern University (NSU) Fischler School of Education is designed for practicing educators with a license in special education who are working with autistic children in Nevada. The program focuses on understanding the needs, assessment, and intervention of students with autism spectrum disorders (ASD). The courses in the program meet the Nevada Department of Education's licensure requirements for a teaching endorsement in autism, and can only be added on to a teaching license in any exceptional student education area. If you teach in Nevada, NSU's School of Education autism education program can help you earn the teaching endorsements you need to achieve your goals in education.

Convenient Delivery Options

Coursework for the Autism Endorsement Program, state approved in Nevada, is available online and at NSU's Nevada Student Educational Center. The online delivery option allows students to receive and submit coursework in their special education classes and interact with participants and professors via the Internet. The site-based delivery option for the endorsement program allows students to take classes in the evenings or on weekends in locations near their homes. These distance education options allow international students and busy professionals to complete their programs without having to leave their jobs or travel long distances.

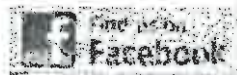
