 - 2. Have you spoken with any of your professors from whom you received a failing grade, and if so, what was the outcome of that discussion?
 - 3. Did you receive any guidance from an advisor?
 - 4. If reinstated, what is your strategy / what will you do differently to maintain satisfactory academic progress?
 - 5. Please explain why you did not withdraw from the course(s) in which you encountered difficulty.

Your appeal, inclusive of your response to the above questions, will initially undergo an informal review through the Office of Academic Affairs. Please note that failure to respond to these questions, or to all questions in the appropriate category, could adversely affect the outcome.
