M.S. in Education with a Specialization in Spanish Language Education

The Master of Science in Education with a Specialization in Spanish Language Education is designed for candidates who have an advanced knowledge of Spanish. Participants will further develop their proficiency in the four skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) while they study innovative teaching methodologies, culture, literature, and linguistics. Curriculum includes skills appropriate for teaching at all K-12 levels, from elementary school Spanish to Advanced Placement courses. Strategies appropriate for teaching Spanish as a foreign language as well as Spanish for heritage speakers will be explored.

This program is designed for already certified/licensed educators and does not lead to a state-issued certificate/license.
